- demonstrate a critical understanding of the contested nature of leadership in education and its connection with the larger socio-political, cultural and historical contexts and issues;
- learn about and critically reflect on leadership theories and appraise contextual and cultural expressions of leadership in education;
- explore various leadership styles and best practices in leadership;
- explore the dynamics of educational leadership and examine its relationship with curriculum and capacity building to achieve better understanding of how both can lead to improved teaching and learning;
- develop an in-depth understanding into the processes involved in leadership development;
- critically analyze situations around leadership and gender and understand leadership's role in addressing issues pertaining to gender equalities in education;
- critically examine how leadership can play a constructive role in managing educational change for sustained and long term impact of change;
- critically analyze the roles and responsibilities of leadership in institutional capacity building;
- be able to appreciate the role of leadership in making policy or mediating policy influences in decision making in education;
- raise informed research questions to understand issues associated with various aspects of educational leadership and its relationships with education reform and development; and
- network with a range of fellow learners in the field, including AKU-IED's MPhil students as classroom peers.
