# Health Promotion, Education and Advocacy

## Standalone Course with Graduate Credits

### March 2 - July 6, 2022 | 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm | Every Wednesday

The Master of Health Policy and Management (MHPM) Programme is pleased to announce standalone course scheduled from March-July, 2022. This course is part of the programme curriculum but can also be taken without enrolling into a degree programme. Course credits can contribute towards a master's degree.

#### **Course Description**

Health Promotion is an approach to prevent diseases and improve health in individuals and populations. The course will present the core concepts of health promotion with particular emphasis on various theories and frameworks, and their application in real-world settings. It will enable students to identify key public health issues using socio-cultural, epidemiological, behavioral, and environmental lens. Students will learn different tools and framework to design and evaluate health promotion programs in different settings to promote the health of individuals and communities through applying key concepts of community empowerment, settings-based health promotion, social marketing, healthy public policy, and the use of technology. The course will also facilitate learners to develop 'behavior change communication strategies' to promote health outcomes. Students will also be oriented to 'health advocacy and mediation' to promote universal access to healthcare. The course will provide learners opportunities to interact with health promotion experts. This will be a highly interactive course that will use flipped teaching and learning techniques, alongside classroom sessions.

#### **Course competencies:**

- Design a health promotion intervention program based on the key principles and strategies of health promotion using the planning framework.
- Develop behavior change communication (BCC) messages utilizing the theories and models used in health promotion.
- Formulate advocacy strategies to achieve particular health goal and objectives.

#### Course credits can contribute towards a master's degree:

Candidates who will achieve a cGPA of 3.5 or above after completing two courses or cGPA of 3.0 or above after completing three courses are exempted from writing the Admission Test. They will be required to appear for an Interview. The courses are valid for three years only for entry into the MHPM programme.

#### **Audience**

- Programme managers from NGO and public sectors, policy makers, health system researchers and health system academia
- Professionals from medicine, allied health professions and biological sciences.

#### **Enrolment Criteria**

Candidates for enrolment in this course must present the following:

Candidates who have at least one year of full time work experience after graduation, in a health-related field or social sector at the time of application (voluntary work, part-time or unpaid internship is not included) and hold at least one of the following degrees are eligible to apply:

Sixteen years of schooling or 4-year education (124-136 credit hours) after HSSC/FA/FSc/Grade 12 equivalent" from an accredited / recognized university in Sciences / Health Sciences / Social Sciences / Psychology / Mathematics / Statistics / Business Management / including but not limited to a BSc (Biology, Biological Sciences, Physics, Physical Sciences), DPT, MBBS, BDS, BScN, DVM, D. Pharm, B Pharm (or equivalent).
