# Stage I

- **1.** <u>Apply Online:</u> Between March 13 and May 4, 2023, by logging on to: <u>www.aku.edu/apply-online</u>
- Make sure you have an active email account, a password that you can remember and your CNIC/Passport handy.

## 2. Documents to upload to complete the online application:

- Paid Fee Challan (application fee is Rs 7000/- In Pakistan and US\$ 150 for candidates overseas).
- A Passport size Photograph- showing your full face.
- CNIC/Passport in case of foreign national.
- Attested SSC / O levels marksheet or equivalent qualification; Equivalence from IBCC, in case of foreign qualification.
- Attested HSSC / A levels marksheet or equivalent qualification; Equivalence from IBCC, in case of foreign qualification.
- HEC attested Undergraduate, Graduate Transcripts and Degree/s as applicable. For unattested documents, upload HEC receipt as evidence. **This is a mandatory requirement.**
- Equivalence from HEC, if applying with Post-RN BScN degree or foreign degree. For Graduate programmes: 16-years of HEC equivalence; For PhD programmes: 18-years of HEC equivalence.
- Experience letter (as applicable)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Reference letters\* (should be received from Referee directly)
