- 1.0 An academic unit is defined as a University Faculty, College, School or Institute. A research unit is defined as programme developed, usually within a Faculty, College, School or Institute, to build the research capacity of faculty members and students.
- 2.0 Proposals to establish / reorganize an academic unit or a research unit will be reviewed in accordance with the processes by which new academic initiatives are approved. (See further the University's Academic Programmes Review Process.)
- 3.0 Requests to create a new academic unit, a new research unit or to reorganize existing academic unit(s) must be presented in the form of a proposal that describes:
 - 3.1 The proposed new organizational unit or changes.
 - 3.2 The purpose and activities of the new unit(s).
 - 3.3 The resources available and/or required to support the new unit(s).
- 4.0 Proposals for the creation of an academic unit will be considered / approved by Academic Council.
- 5.0 On the recommendation of Academic Council, the Admissions and Student Affairs Committee (ASAC) of the Board of Trustees will consider / approve the creation of new academic units as well as any recommendation for the reorganization of an academic unit.
- 6.0 Proposals for the creation of a research unit will be considered / approved by the University Research Council and sent to the Academic Council for information.
- 7.0 On the recommendation of University Research Council, the Admissions and Student Affairs Committee (ASAC) of the Board of Trustees will consider / approve the creation of new research units as well as any recommendation for the reorganization of a research unit.
