## Responding to today's needs

FAS is launching a four-year undergraduate degree programme in the following four areas: Asian and Middle Eastern Studies; Social Development Studies; Politics, Philosophy and Economics; and Human and Environmental Biology. With a focus on critical thought, communication, creativity and service, the programmes will actively nurture an entrepreneurial mindset and empower students to live meaningful, ethical lives.

Co-curricular activities will offer opportunities for selfdiscovery and collaboration, allowing students to cultivate friendships and learn new skills. Under the mentorship of our world-class faculty, FAS students will enjoy a life-changing educational experience unlike any other in Pakistan.

Moreover, students will engage in reflexive community engagement. The programme features internship placements in diverse community settings, a Development Lab enabling problem-solving knowledge, and a wide variety of on-campus and community-based co-curricular activities.

These leaders are characterised by personal integrity, intellectual excellence and a commitment to the communities in which they live. A great education in the arts and sciences prepares students for a range of professions and careers in an increasingly technological and data-driven world.
