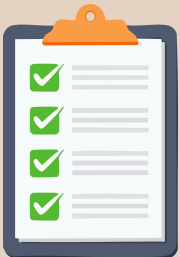

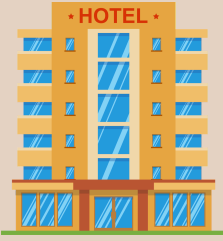

06. Travel & Entry Requirements



All travellers requiring a visa must apply through Kenya's official online system at: <https://etakenya.go.ke/>.

Applications should be submitted at least three working days (72hrs) in advance of travel. Click [here for details of those who are exempt](#).



Proof of Yellow Fever vaccination is required for travellers arriving from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission.



Please carry with you a return air ticket and valid travel document with at least three blank pages in your passport when you travel.

Currency and Payments

The local currency is the Kenyan shilling (KES/KSh). The exchange rate from USD to KES/KSh is approximately USD1 = KES129.



The rate is subject to currency fluctuations. Hotels and many other establishments also accept major credit cards (Visa or MasterCard predominantly).

A passport will be required for all foreign exchange transactions.

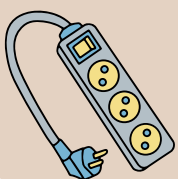

Weather and Time

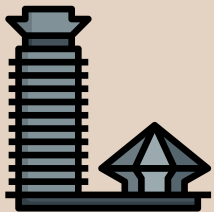


In June, Nairobi typically experiences mild weather with an average **high-temperature of 24°C (75.2°F)** and an average **low-temperature of 12°C (53.6°F)**. Light layers and a warm jacket are recommended, especially for mornings and evenings.



Nairobi is 3 hours ahead of GMT.
