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Health Sector Reform and Evaluation

Standalone Course with Graduate Credits

August 3 – November 27, 2026 | 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm | Every Monday

The Master of Health Policy and Management (MHPM) Programme is pleased to announce a standalone course scheduled from August to November 2026. This course is part of the programme curriculum and may also be taken without enrolling in a degree programme. Credits earned can contribute towards a master's degree.

Course Description

Focus: A practical, policy-oriented course on health system reforms and evaluation, equipping professionals to analyse, design, and assess reforms in health systems.

What you learn: Skills in health sector analysis, governance and financing reform, regulatory frameworks, and M&E of reform initiatives using real-world examples from Low-Middle-Income Countries.

Updated and validated content aligned with leading universities.

How you learn: The blended learning approach comprising in-person sessions, live online classes, and asynchronous learning activities, interactive lectures, case studies, group discussions, collaborative exercises, and practical applications.

Who teaches: Guest facilitators from national and international guest facilitators and policy practitioners.

Impact for Participants: Participants will be equipped to diagnose health system gaps, design reform strategies, and apply M&E frameworks for evidence-informed decision-making.

Course credits can contribute towards a master's degree:

Candidates who will achieve a cGPA of 3.5 or above after completing two courses or a cGPA of 3.0 or above after completing three courses are exempted from writing the Admission Test. They will be required to appear for an Interview. The courses are valid for three years only for entry into the MHPM programme.

- Programme managers from NGO and public sectors, policymakers, health system researchers, and health system academia
- Professionals from medicine, allied health professions, and biological sciences.

Enrolment Criteria

Candidates for enrolment in this course must present the following:

Candidates who have at least one year of full-time work experience after graduation, in a health-related field or social sector at the time of application (voluntary work, part-time or unpaid internship is not included) and hold at least one of the following degrees are eligible to apply:

Sixteen years of schooling or 4-year education (124-136 credit hours) after HSSC/FA/FSc/Grade 12 equivalent from an accredited / recognized university in Sciences / Health Sciences / Social Sciences / Psychology / Mathematics / Statistics / Business Management / including but not limited to a BSc (Biology, Biological Sciences, Physics, Physical Sciences), DPT, MBBS, BDS, BScN, DVM, D. Pharm, B Pharm (or equivalent).
