




Launch of the Teachers Academy (4 min read)

The Network of Quality, Teaching and Learning (QTL_net) hosted a virtual event on 22nd of September 2020 to announce the inaugural call for membership of the AKU Teachers' Academy. The event included addresses from Dr. Debas, our Chair, the President and Provost and a Deans panel discussion on the importance of Rewarding and Recognising Teaching Excellence. The event was attended by 180 academic staff and AKU leadership. It was followed by an interactive session 'The Human Library: Meet a Teaching Champion', which was led by 11 faculty from across all academic entities and campuses and attended by 65 faculty. QTL Strategic Plan Now Available (3 min read)

Based on the unit review of the first five-years since being established a second QTL_net strategic plan (2021-2025) has been developed that identifies 4 keys goals: A quality culture across the Academy; Support for Faculty on teaching including with technology; Scholarship and Innovation; and Reward and Recognition of Teaching. Technology, Students as Partners and an Enabling Environment will be the foundation to this plan with the Teachers' Academy creating a sustainable resource base for QTL_net. Faculty and Student Experience Surveys with the rapid transition to online and remote learning (2 min read)

As a response to the COVID19 pandemic, 2 faculty and student experience surveys were conducted between 21st September and the 2nd October 2020, with questionnaires benchmarked to the EDUCAUSE TOOLKIT (2020). The overall aim of the survey was to understand faculty and student experiences of rapid online and remote teaching during the first semester after COVID19. Teaching and Learning Enhancement Workshop (4 min read)





The Network of Quality, Teaching and Learning (QTL_net) offered its sixth but first-ever online Rethinking Teaching Workshop (RTT) from October 19th to November 3rd, 2020. Twenty-four (24) faculty members and academic support staff from different disciplines attended the workshop over the course of eight (8) invigorating half-days with a blend of synchronous and asynchronous sessions.
