Renaming of the Teachers' Academy by the Chancellor (2 min read)



"I am very pleased to inform you that the Chancellor announced that the AKU Teachers' Academy will be named the Haile T. Debas Teachers' Academy to recognize Dr. Debas for his contributions to the University, and particularly for promoting the highest standards of teaching and learning." The Haile T. Debas Teachers' Academy comprises of a prestigious group of outstanding teachers at AKU who are recognized for their excellence in teaching, mentorship, and leadership in higher education. Currently, there are 19 members of the AKU Teachers' Academy, of which 16 have HEA fellowships.

Dr. Debas continues to serve as the Teachers' Academy Advisory Body (TAAB) Chair. He is the founder of The Haile T. Debas Academy of Medical Educator at the University of California San Francisco, the first-ever Academy in the world. Dr. Debas plays an instrumental role in leading the agenda of the Haile T. Debas Teachers' Academy and thus raising the profile of teaching and learning at AKU.

On Monday, 7th March 2022, the **Giving in Gratitude** Faculty and Staff Campaign was launched, with the aim of celebrating and strengthening The Haile T. Debas

Teachers' Academy.

QTL_net hosted the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning UnConference entitled 'Reimagining Learning Centred Teaching in a COVD-19 world' on November 29 and 30, 2021, where QTL_net engaged some 800 participants, mainly faculty and students, across the AKU and AKDN from South and Central Asia, East Africa, Europe, and North America.

In the SoTL UnConference 2021, participants were promised an 'Un'Conference-like experience, with no zoom fatigue, through a myriad of synchronous and asynchronous activities on offer like the Global Solutions Café and Co-creation Learning Labs with student-faculty collaborations; fun reflection through Quarantine Teaching Bloopers and Pecha Kucha stories and faculty development opportunities by participating in Flipped Learning Master Classes and Peer-Reflective Studios. The evaluations showed that 88% of participants found the sessions engaging, with effective teaching methodologies that they intend to apply in practice.

President Sulaiman attended the Opening Ceremony of SoTL UnConference 2021 and addressed the audience, talking about his support for faculty and the importance of focusing on students and a learning-centered experience.

Faculty Engagement with QTL net in 2021 (1 min Read)



In 2021, QTL_net conducted over 40 online professional development sessions, resulting in 798 faculty participations from 305 unique faculty members globally. The Network successfully engaged and reached 75% and more of the faculty members for most of the global entities. Over the past 5 years, QTL_net has cumulatively reached 95% of the faculty, with a return rate of 88%, with QTL workshops and sessions being attended multiple times by faculty members. We are thankful for the continued support of our Deans and the Teaching Champions, including HEA Fellows and TA Members who support teaching excellence at AKU.
