At the Aga Khan University Hospital (AKUH), we believe that every person has the right to high-quality, compassionate medical care.

Through the Patient Welfare Programme (PWP), the physicians and nurses at AKUH are able to treat patients who might not otherwise seek treatment due to their financial situation.

With the help of the PWP, patients from low-income backgrounds are able to access the full range of hospital, clinical, diagnostic, and laboratory services available at AKUH. And no patient who is eligible for support is ever turned away from AKUH.

The Patient Welfare Programme was established when the Hospital was founded in 1985. AKU is committed to serving the underserved regardless of religion, gender, race, ethnicity, socio-economic background or place of residence. And patients who receive PWP assistance are given the same level of care as those who can pay, so that everyone is treated with the dignity and respect they deserve.


