Message from the Chair, Department of Surgery

I welcome all the national and international participants to the 5th AKU Annual Surgical Conference of the Aga Khan University, Karachi. The AKU Annual Surgical Conferences has provided the Aga Khan University, particularly the Department of Surgery, a platform to maintain its reputation as regional academic leaders.

While we've made significant progress in medical care on a global scale, our progress in terms of trauma management has been rather stunted. When discussing the expanse of trauma care, one cannot avoid mentioning the value of its multimodal nature, and the variety of personnel involved in its care. AKU is ideally positioned to create an impact in trauma care in a low-middle-income region of the world. Our focus is on how to develop, policies, processes and guidelines to save precious lives of trauma victims by following a systematic approach for improving trauma care, training and research. That's why this year's theme of the conference is 'Trauma: Striving for Change'. The goal of this conference is to understand these issues and come up with concrete steps that can be implemented within tight timeframes after the conference. A conference is meaningless if it does not lead us to practical steps.

The care for trauma victims begins before the hospital, often in the absence of any trained professional. This is also the golden period to minimise further insult to the patient. The way forward is to keep community and stakeholders involved and educate not only the caretakers but also train the masses to be able to help each other. Members of the community must be brought forth as 'first-responders' and provided with proper training. A good example of this is the American College of Surgeons' 'Stop the Bleed' initiative, which as of September 2019 has trained over a million individuals as 'immediate responders' to assist patient care, until professional help can arrive.

The Centre of Excellence for Trauma and Emergencies (CoE-T&E) at AKU was approved for commissioning in August 2019. The CoE-T&E will launch its flagship programme Pakistan Life Savers Programme (PLSP) in this conference. PLSP aims to train 10 million Pakistanis in life-saving skills of CPR and bleeding control. The figure of ten million trained bystanders will ensure that 5% of Pakistan's population (1 in 20) is trained. We plan to initiate this programme in Karachi and Islamabad and subsequently, through sustained efforts and partnerships, reach out to all major cities of Pakistan. PLSP will target Pakistani youth (high school, college and university students) as life savers. This will be achieved through partnership with key stakeholders in health and education sector.

I am thankful to all the guests who have gathered here upon our invitation. I must also thank our collaborating partners and contributors who have helped make this event possible. Please join me in congratulating the Organizing Committee for this herculean effort.



Ali al-Ḥusayn Ibn-e-Sina, also known as Avicenna was a Persian polymath who is regarded as one of the most significant thinkers and writers of the Islamic Golden Age. Regarded as the Father of Medicine, his most famous works are The Book of Healing – a philosophical and scientific encyclopaedia, and a five-volume medical encyclopaedia: The Canon of Medicine which became a standard medical text at many universities and remained in use as late as 1650. Besides philosophy and medicine, Avicenna's corpus includes writings on astronomy, alchemy, geography and geology, psychology, Islamic theology, logic, mathematics, physics and poetry.



Abu al-Qasim al-Zahrawi, also known as Albucasis, is considered the Father of Surgery. His outstanding contribution to medicine is his encyclopaedic work The Kitab Al-Tasrif, a long and detailed work in thirty treatises. The book contains the earliest pictures of surgical instruments and of all the contents of this landmark publication, the part on surgery became the most famous and had by far the greatest influence. In it, he developed all aspects of surgery and its various branches, including ophthalmology, ear, nose, and throat, head and neck, general surgery, obstetrics and gynaecology, military medicine, urology, and orthopaedics. This was a standard text well into the 1700s and was taught to medical students at major universities in Europe until the late 1800s.
