"We were on the verge of despair," Israr Ahmed, father of the nine-month old twins, said. "Then one night I had a dream that Ayan and Aman were separate. That dream gave me hope." Still, AKUH seemed out of reach. "We were convinced that this hospital is only for the rich and can never be a possibility for us. But my Allah made AKUH the saviour of my children. The doctors told us not to worry about the expenses, as they would be taken care of by the Patient Welfare Programme."
